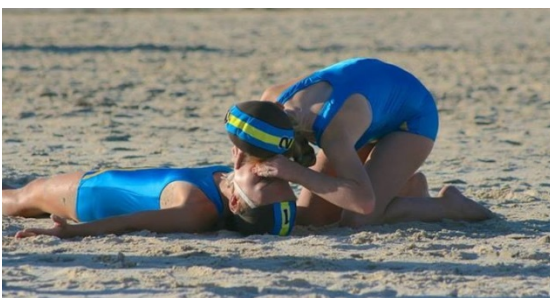
Awards gained under this programme include IRB Crews, first aide, Spinal management, ART., Marine licences, that continue to strengthen our patrols.
